## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to direct the Secretary of Defense to prescribe regulations to allow emergency response providers to use mobile commissaries or exchange stores deployed to an area covered by a declaration of a major disaster or emergency under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “First Responder Ac-  
5 cess to Mobile Exchanges Act” or “FRAME Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. USE BY EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROVIDERS OF MO-**  
2 **BILE COMMISSARIES OR EXCHANGE STORES**  
3 **DEPLOYED TO AREAS COVERED BY A DEC-**  
4 **LARATION OF MAJOR DISASTER OR EMER-**  
5 **GENCY.**

6 Section 1146 of title 10, United States Code, is  
7 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-  
8 section:

9 “(d) EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROVIDERS DURING A  
10 DECLARED MAJOR DISASTER OR EMERGENCY.—The Sec-  
11 retary of Defense shall prescribe regulations to allow an  
12 emergency response provider (as that term is defined in  
13 section 2 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (Public  
14 Law 107–296; 6 U.S.C. 101)) to use a mobile commissary  
15 or exchange store deployed to an area covered by a dec-  
16 laration of a major disaster or emergency under section  
17 401 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emer-  
18 gency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5170).”.
