## A BILL

To provide a temporary extension of unemployment insurance, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Responsible COBRA,
- 5 Unemployment, and Poverty Extension Act".

### SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE PRO-2 VISIONS. 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—(1) Section 4007 of the Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–252; 4 5 26 U.S.C. 3304 note) is amended— 6 (A) by striking "June 2, 2010" each place it 7 appears and inserting "September 30, 2010"; 8 (B) in the heading for subsection (b)(2), by striking "JUNE 2, 2010" and inserting "SEPTEMBER 9 10 30, 2010"; and 11 (C) in subsection (b)(3), by striking "November 12 6, 2010" and inserting "March 1, 2011". 13 (2) Section 2005 of the Assistance for Unemployed Workers and Struggling Families Act, as contained in Public Law 111–5 (26 U.S.C. 3304 note; 123 Stat. 444), 16 is amended— 17 (A) by striking "June 2, 2010" each place it 18 appears and inserting "September 30, 2010"; and 19 (B) in subsection (c), by striking "November 6, 2010" and inserting "March 1, 2011". 20 21 (3) Section 5 of the Unemployment Compensation 22 Extension Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–449; 26 U.S.C. 23 3304 note) is amended by striking "November 6, 2010" and inserting "March 1, 2011". 24

- 15 SEC. 3. EXTENSION AND IMPROVEMENT OF PREMIUM AS-
- 16 SISTANCE FOR COBRA BENEFITS.
- 17 (a) Extension of Eligibility Period.—Sub-
- 18 section (a)(3)(A) of section 3001 of division B of the
- 19 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public
- 20 Law 111-5), as amended by section 3(a) of the Tem-
- 21 porary Extension Act of 2010 (Public Law 111-144) and
- 22 section 3(a) of the Continuing Extension Act of 2010
- 23 (Public Law 111–157), is amended by striking "May 31,
- 24 2010" and inserting "September 30, 2010".

- 1 (b) Rules Relating to 2010 Extension.—Sub-
- 2 section (a) of section 3001 of division B of the American
- 3 Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111–
- 4 5), as amended by section 3(b) of the Continuing Exten-
- 5 sion Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–157), is amended by

- 8 EXTENSION.—In the case of an individual who, with

- 17 (c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 18 this section shall take effect as if included in the provisions
- 19 of section 3001 of division B of the American Recovery
- 20 and Reinvestment Act of 2009.
- 21 SEC. 4. EXTENSION OF USE OF 2009 POVERTY GUIDELINES.
- 22 Section 1012 of the Department of Defense Appro-
- 23 priations Act, 2010 (Public Law 111–118), as amended
- 24 by section 6 of the Continuing Extension Act of 2010

- 1 (Public Law 111–157), is amended by striking "May 31,
- 2 2010" and inserting "September 30, 2010".

#### 3 SEC. 5. USE OF STIMULUS FUNDS TO OFFSET SPENDING.

- 4 The unobligated balance of each amount appro-
- 5 priated or made available under the American Recovery
- 6 and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111–5) (other
- 7 than under title X of division A of such Act) is rescinded
- 8 pro rata such that the aggregate amount of such rescis-
- 9 sions equals \$27,000,000,000 in order to offset the net
- 10 increase in spending resulting from the provisions of, and
- 11 amendments made by, sections 2 through 4. The Director
- 12 of the Office of Management and Budget shall report to
- 13 each congressional committee the amounts so rescinded
- 14 within the jurisdiction of such committee.

### 15 SEC. 6. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

- 16 (a) In General.—The budgetary effects of this Act,
- 17 for the purpose of complying with the Statutory Pay-As-
- 18 You-Go Act of 2010, shall be determined by reference to
- 19 the latest statement titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO
- 20 Legislation" for this Act, submitted for printing in the
- 21 Congressional Record by the Chairman of the House
- 22 Budget Committee, provided that such statement has been
- 23 submitted prior to the vote on passage.
- 24 (b) Emergency Designation for Congressional
- 25 Enforcement.—In the House of Representatives, this

- 1 Act, with the exception of section 5, is designated as an
- 2 emergency for purposes of pay-as-you-go principles. In the
- 3 Senate, this Act is designated as an emergency require-
- 4 ment pursuant to section 403(a) of S. Con. Res. 13 (111th
- 5 Congress), the concurrent resolution on the budget for fis-
- 6 cal year 2010.
- 7 (c) Emergency Designation for Statutory
- 8 Paygo.—This Act, with the exception of section 5, is des-
- 9 ignated as an emergency requirement pursuant to section
- 10 4(g) of the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010 (Public
- 11 Law 111–139; 2 U.S.C. 933(g)).

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
