Mr. ROSE of New York introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Homeland Security

A BILL

To direct the Under Secretary for Intelligence and Analysis of the Department of Homeland Security to develop and disseminate a threat assessment regarding threats to the United States associated with foreign violent white supremacist extremist organizations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Transnational White
5 Supremacist Extremism Review Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. THREAT ASSESSMENT.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Under Secretary for Intel-
3 ligence and Analysis of the Department of Homeland Se-
4 curity shall, in coordination with appropriate Federal
5 partners, develop a terrorism threat assessment regarding
6 threats to the United States associated with foreign vio-
7 lent white supremacist extremist organizations. Consistent
8 with the protection of classified and confidential unclassi-
9 fied information, the Under Secretary shall share the
10 threat assessment developed under this section with State,
11 local, and Tribal law enforcement officials, including offi-
12 cials who operate within State, local, and regional fusion
13 centers through the Department of Homeland Security
14 State, Local, and Regional Fusion Center Initiative estab-
15 lished in accordance with section 210A of the Homeland
16 Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 124h).

17 (b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “foreign
18 violent white supremacist extremist organization” means
19 an organization, such as a neo-Nazi or racist skinhead
20 group or militia, based outside the United States, that is
21 engaged in the planning or execution of racially or eth-
22 nically motivated acts of terrorism or other targeted vio-
23 lence motivated by white supremacist extremism, particu-
24 larly against immigrants or individuals perceived to be im-
25 migrants, African Americans or other people of African

- 1 descent, Jews, Muslims, or other people perceived to be
- 2 ethnic minorities or otherwise not perceived to be white.
