## A BILL

To permit the territories of the United States to provide and furnish statues for placement in the national statuary hall.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PLACEMENT OF STATUES FROM TERRITORIES**

4 **IN NATIONAL STATUARY HALL.**

5 (a) PLACEMENT OF STATUES.—Section 1814 of the  
6 Revised Statutes of the United States (2 U.S.C. 2131)  
7 is amended by adding at the end the following new sen-  
8 tence: “For purposes of this section, the term ‘State’ in-  
9 cludes American Samoa, Guam, the Commonwealth of the

1 Northern Mariana Islands, the Commonwealth of Puerto  
2 Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands.”.

3 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT RELATING TO RE-  
4 PLACEMENT OF STATUES.—Section 311 of the Legislative  
5 Branch Appropriations Act, 2001 (2 U.S.C. 2132) is  
6 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-  
7 section:

8 “(f) For purposes of this section, the term ‘State’ in-  
9 cludes American Samoa, Guam, the Commonwealth of the  
10 Northern Mariana Islands, the Commonwealth of Puerto  
11 Rico, and the United States Virgin Islands.”.
