1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Crimea Annexation3 Non-recognition Act".

4 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST UNITED STATES RECOGNI5 TION OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION'S CLAIM 6 OF SOVEREIGNTY OVER CRIMEA.

7 (a) STATEMENT OF POLICY.—It is the policy of the
8 United States not to recognize the Russian Federation's
9 claim of sovereignty over Crimea, its airspace, or its terri10 torial waters.

(b) PROHIBITION.—In accordance with subsection
(a), no Federal department or agency may take any action
or extend any assistance that implies recognition of the
Russian Federation's claim of sovereignty over Crimea, its
airspace, or its territorial waters.

(c) WAIVER.—The President may waive the prohibition in subsection (b) on a case-by-case basis if the President determines that it is vital to the national security
interests of the United States to do so.
