A BILL

To require eligible institutions under title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 to designate a Clery Compliance Officer to ensure compliance with the requirements of the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Clery Compliance Offi-
5 cer Designation Act of 2020”.

1 **SEC. 2. CLERY COMPLIANCE OFFICER REQUIRED.**

2 Section 485(f) of the Higher Education Act of 1965
3 (20 U.S.C. 1092(f)), is amended—

4 (1) by redesignating paragraph (18) as para-
5 graph (19); and

6 (2) by inserting after paragraph (17) the fol-
7 lowing:

8 “(18) Each eligible institution participating in any
9 program under this title, other than a foreign institution
10 of higher education, shall, beginning on January 1, 2022,
11 and each year thereafter, designate at least one Clery
12 Compliance Officer who shall—

13 “(A) carry out the responsibilities associated
14 with the information collection requirements of this
15 subsection; and

16 “(B) in accordance with paragraph (5), submit
17 to the Secretary a copy of the statistics required to
18 be made available under paragraph (1)(F).”.
