A BILL

To amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to improve diversity in accelerated student learning programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Diversity Advance-
5 ments in Accelerated Programs Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DIVERSITY IN ACCELERATED STUDENT LEARNING**
7 **PROGRAMS.**

8 (a) STATE ACTIVITIES.—Section 4104(b)(3)(A) of
9 the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20
10 U.S.C. 7114(b)(3)(A)) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “or” at the end of clause (i);

2 and

3 (2) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(iii) establishing an equity office to
5 provide recommendations and develop pro-
6 grams to improve diversity in such acceler-
7 ated learning programs, and address other
8 inequalities with respect to raising student
9 academic achievement; or

10 “(iv) carrying out universal screening
11 to determine eligibility for such accelerated
12 learning programs;”.

13 (b) LOCAL ACTIVITIES.—Section 4107(a)(3)(D) of
14 the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20
15 U.S.C. 7117(a)(3)(D)) is amended—

16 (1) in clause (i), by striking “or”; and

17 (2) by adding at the end the following:

18 “(iii) establishing an equity office to
19 provide recommendations and develop pro-
20 grams to improve diversity in such acceler-
21 ated learning programs, and address other
22 inequalities with respect to raising student
23 academic achievement; or

1 “(iv) carrying out universal screening
2 to determine eligibility for such accelerated
3 learning programs;”.

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
