Mr. Ted Lieu of California introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To prohibit the sale of shark parts, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Shark Sales Elimi-
- 5 nation Act of 2019".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON SALE OF SHARK PARTS.
- 7 (a) Prohibition.—Except as provided in section 3,
- 8 no person shall possess, offer for sale, sell, or purchase
- 9 any shark part or product containing any shark part.
- 10 (b) Penalty.—For purposes of section 308(a) of the
- 11 Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Manage-
- 12 ment Act (16 U.S.C. 1858(a)), a violation of this section

shall be treated as an act prohibited by section 307 of that Act (16 U.S.C. 1857). SEC. 3. EXEMPTION FOR TRADITIONAL FISHERIES, EDU-4 CATION, AND SCIENCE. 5 Section 2 shall not apply with respect to possession of a shark part that was taken lawfully under a State, territorial, or Federal license or permit to take or land 8 sharks, if the shark part is separated from the shark in 9 a manner consistent with the license or permit and is— 10 (1) destroyed or discarded; 11 (2) used for noncommercial subsistence pur-12 poses in accordance with State or territorial law; or 13 (3) used solely for display or research purposes 14 by a museum, college, or university, or other person 15 under a State or Federal permit to conduct noncommercial scientific research. 16 17 SEC. 4. DEFINITIONS. 18 In this Act: 19 (1) SHARK.—The term "shark" means any spe-20 cies of the orders Pristiophoriformes, Squatini-21 formes. Squaliformes, Hexanchiformes, 22 formes, Carchariniformes, Orectolobiformes, 23 Heterodontiformes.

- 1 (2) Shark part.—The term "shark part"
- 2 means any shark or raw, dried, or otherwise proc-
- 3 essed detached part of a shark.

4 SEC. 5. STATE AUTHORITY.

- Nothing in this Act affects any right of a State or
- 6 territory of the United States to adopt or enforce any reg-
- 7 ulation or standard that is more stringent than a regula-
- 8 tion or standard in effect under this Act.
