Mr. OGLES (for himself and Mr. TIFFANY) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Homeland Security from granting certain aliens temporary protected status.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Temporary Pro-
5 tected Status for Terrorists Act” or the “No TPS for Ter-
6 rorists Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. CERTAIN ALIENS INELIGIBLE FOR TEMPORARY**
8 **PROTECTED STATUS.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-
10 rity may not grant a covered alien temporary protected

1 status in the United States pursuant to section 244 of
2 the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1254a).

3 (b) COVERED ALIEN.—In this section, the term “cov-
4 ered alien” means an alien who is a holder of a passport
5 or other travel document issued by the Palestinian Author-
6 ity.
