# **A BILL**

To eliminate unnecessary reporting requirements for unfunded programs under the Office of Justice Programs.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Reporting Efficiency  
5 Improvement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF REPORTS FOR UNFUNDED PRO-**  
7 **GRAMS UNDER THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PRO-**  
8 **GRAMS.**

9       (a) DNA IDENTIFICATION GRANTS.—Section 2406  
10 of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets  
11 Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796kk–5) is amended—

12           (1) by striking “(a) REPORTS TO ATTORNEY  
13 GENERAL.—”; and

14           (2) by striking subsection (b).

15       (b) POLICE CORPS PROGRAM.—Section 200113 of  
16 the Police Corps Act (42 U.S.C. 14102) is repealed.
