- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Improving Emergency
- 3 Disease Response via Housing Act of 2020".

4 SEC. 2. DATA SHARING BETWEEN HUD AND HHS.

- 5 (a) In General.—For the purpose of increasing the
- 6 ability of the Secretary of Health and Human Services to
- 7 target outreach to populations vulnerable to contracting
- 8 coronavirus, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Develop-
- 9 ment shall share with the Secretary of Health and Human
- 10 Services information regarding the location of projects for
- 11 supportive housing for the elderly assisted under section
- 12 202 of the Housing Act of 1959 (12 U.S.C. 1701g) and
- 13 the location of Continuums of Care with high concentra-
- 14 tion of unsheltered homelessness.
- 15 (b) Removal of Personally Identifiable In-
- 16 FORMATION.—In sharing the information required under
- 17 subsection (a), the Secretary of Housing and Urban De-
- 18 velopment shall ensure that appropriate administrative
- 19 and physical safeguards are in place to remove all person-
- 20 ally identifiable information.
- 21 (c) Consultation.—The Secretary of Housing and
- 22 Urban Development shall consult with the Secretary of
- 23 Health and Human Services promptly after the date of
- 24 the enactment of this Act to provide for the sharing of
- 25 the information required under subsection (a).

- 1 (d) Limitation.—Information shared pursuant to
- 2 this Act shall not be shared beyond the Department of
- 3 Health and Human Services or used for purposes beyond
- 4 those intended in the Act.
