3 **SECTION 1. NO PAY ADJUSTMENT FOR MEMBERS OF CON-**
4 **GRESS IN FISCAL YEAR 2013 OR 2014.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no ad-
6 justment shall be made under section 601(a) of the Legis-

1 lative Reorganization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 31), relating
2 to compensation of Members of Congress, during fiscal
3 year 2013 or 2014.
