Mr. LEVIN (for himself, Mr. ARRINGTON, and Ms. HOULAHAN) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to establish additional factors that determine pathways in the Transition Assistance Program of the Department of Defense.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Transition Improve-
5 ment by Estimating Risk Act” or the “TIER Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO PATHWAYS FOR COUNSELING IN**
7 **THE TRANSITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**

8 Section 1142(c)(1) of title 10, United States Code,
9 is amended—

1 (1) in subparagraph (E), by striking “Dis-
2 ability” and inserting “Potential or confirmed dis-
3 ability”;

4 (2) in subparagraph (F), by striking “Char-
5 acter” and inserting “Potential or confirmed char-
6 acter”;

7 (3) by redesignating subparagraph (M) as sub-
8 paragraph (R); and

9 (4) by inserting after subparagraph (L) the fol-
10 lowing:

11 “(M) Child care requirements of the member
12 (including whether a dependent of the member is en-
13 rolled in the Exceptional Family Member Program).

14 “(N) The employment status of other adults in
15 the household of the member.

16 “(O) The location of the duty station of the
17 member (including whether the member was sepa-
18 rated from family while on duty).

19 “(P) The effects of operating tempo and per-
20 sonnel tempo on the member and the household of
21 the member.

22 “(Q) Whether the member is an Indian or
23 urban Indian, as those terms are defined in section

1 4 of the Indian Health Care Improvement Act (Pub-
2 lic Law 94-437; 25 U.S.C. 1603).”.

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
