## A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to require institutions of higher education to track and record additional information on hate crimes, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Combating Hate  
5 Across Campus Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE OF CAMPUS SECURITY POLICY AND**  
2 **CAMPUS CRIME STATISTICS.**

3 Section 485(f)(1)(F)(ii) of the Higher Education Act  
4 of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1092(f)(1)(F)(ii)) is amended by strik-  
5 ing “which data shall be collected and reported according  
6 to category of prejudice; and” and inserting “which data  
7 shall—

8 “(I) be collected and reported ac-  
9 cording to category of prejudice; and

10 “(II) disaggregated by subcat-  
11 egories based on the identity of the  
12 targeted individual or group, includ-  
13 ing—

14 “(aa) anti-Semitism;

15 “(bb) Islamophobia;

16 “(cc) homophobia;

17 “(dd) biphobia;

18 “(ee) transphobia;

19 “(ff) disability bias;

20 “(gg) in the case of an ac-  
21 tion targeting a particular ethnic  
22 group, the identity of the ethnic  
23 group; and

1                   “(hh) such other subcat-  
2                   egories as the Secretary deter-  
3                   mines appropriate; and”.
