## A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Interior to remove the Emancipation Monument from Lincoln Park in the District of Columbia, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Emancipation Statue  
5 Removal Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF EMANCIPATION MONUMENT.**

7 (a) REMOVAL.—The Secretary of the Interior shall  
8 ensure that the Emancipation Monument is removed from  
9 Lincoln Park in the District of Columbia.

1 (b) DONATION.—The Secretary shall donate the  
2 Emancipation Monument to a museum or other similar  
3 entity. The recipient of the Emancipation Monument may  
4 not store, display, or exhibit the monument outside. If the  
5 monument is stored, displayed, or exhibited outside, own-  
6 ership of the monument will revert back to the Federal  
7 Government.
