A BILL

To provide for a regional center for security studies for the Arctic in the Department of Defense, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TED STEVENS ARCTIC CENTER FOR SECURITY**
4 **STUDIES.**

5 (a) ESTABLISHMENT REQUIRED.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense
7 shall establish and administer for purposes of sec-
8 tion 342 of title 10, United States Code, and other
9 applicable provisions of law, a Department of De-

1 fense Regional Center for Security Studies for the
2 Arctic.

3 (2) DESIGNATION.—The Regional Center for
4 Security Studies established and administered pur-
5 suant to paragraph (1) shall be known as the “Ted
6 Stevens Arctic Center for Security Studies”.

7 (3) LOCATION.—The Regional Center for Secu-
8 rity Studies established and administered pursuant
9 to paragraph (1) shall be located in such location in
10 a non-contiguous State as the Secretary considers
11 appropriate.

12 (b) SIXTH REGIONAL CENTER FOR SECURITY STUD-
13 IES.—Section 184(b)(2) of title 10, United States Code,
14 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
15 paragraph:

16 “(F) The Ted Stevens Arctic Center for Secu-
17 rity Studies, located in a non-contiguous State.”.

18 (c) ACCEPTANCE OF GIFTS AND DONATIONS.—Sec-
19 tion 2611(a)(2) of such title is amended by adding at the
20 end the following new subparagraph:

21 “(F) The Ted Stevens Arctic Center for Secu-
22 rity Studies.”.

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
