To require plain language and the inclusion of key words in covered notices that are clear, concise, and accessible to small business concerns, and for other purposes.

3 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

4 (1) COVERED NOTICE.—The term “covered no-
5 tice” means a notice pertaining to small business
6 concerns published by a Federal agency on the sin-
7 gle Government-wide point of entry described under
8 section 1708 of title 41, United States Code.

9 (2) SMALL BUSINESS ACT DEFINITIONS.—The
10 terms “Federal agency” and “small business con-
11 cern” have the meanings given those terms, respec-
12 tively, in section 3 of the Small Business Act (15
13 U.S.C. 632).

14 **SEC. 3. COMPLIANCE WITH CUTGO.**

15 No additional amounts are authorized to be appro-
16 priated to carry out this Act or the amendments made
17 by this Act.
