under the Older Americans Act of 1965.

A BILL

Making emergency supplemental appropriations for social isolation services under the Older Americans Act of 1965.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the “Strengthening Social
5 Connections Act of 2020”.

6 SEC. 2. SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS.

7 The following sums are hereby appropriated, out of
8 any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,

1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, and for
2 other purposes, namely:

3 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN
4 SERVICES

5 ADMINISTRATION FOR COMMUNITY LIVING
6 AGING AND DISABILITY SERVICES PROGRAMS

7 For an additional amount for “Aging and Disability
8 Services Programs”, for carrying out the Older Americans
9 Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3001 et seq.) (“OAA”),
10 \$104,000,000, to remain available through September 30,
11 2022, of which—

12 (1) \$80,000,000 shall be made available for
13 supportive services under part B of title III of such
14 Act (42 U.S.C. 3030d et seq.), provided that such
15 amount made available under this paragraph shall
16 be made available for prevention and mitigation ac-
17 tivities focused on addressing extended social isola-
18 tion among older individuals, which may include ac-
19 tivities for investments in technological equipment
20 and solutions or other strategies aimed at alleviating
21 the negative health effects of social isolation due to
22 long-term stay-at-home recommendations for older
23 individuals for the duration of the coronavirus pan-
24 demic;

(B) coordinated efforts to prioritize activities that prevent and address social isolation and loneliness among a wide range of older individuals, including activities for strategies that identify best practices, support demonstration of innovative approaches in the aging services network, conduct public education, develop partnerships and collaborations to advance program objectives, or enhance the capacity of the aging network, and other activities as appropriate to mitigate social isolation and loneliness among older individuals; and

(A) populations targeted under section 306(a)(4)(A)(i)(I) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 3026(a)(4)(A)(i)(I)); and

13 *Provided*, That, notwithstanding section 304(d)(1)(D) of
14 the OAA (42 U.S.C. 3024(d)(1)(D)) or any other provi-
15 sion in such Act, the requirement for a non-Federal share
16 under such section shall not apply for fiscal year 2021
17 with respect to services under part B of title III of such
18 Act: *Provided further*, That the amount appropriated
19 under this heading is designated by Congress as being for
20 an emergency requirement pursuant to section
21 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency
22 Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 901(b)(2)(A)(i)).

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
