2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMOUNT OF EMERGENCY EIDL ADVANCES FOR**
4 **CERTAIN VETERANS SERVICE ORGANIZA-**
5 **TIONS.**

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Ad-
7 ministrator of the Small Business Administration shall en-
8 sure that a veterans service organization with not more

1 than one employee that applies for an advance under sec-
2 tion 1110(e) of the CARES Act (15 U.S.C. 9005(e)) is
3 not subject to a cap on such advance that is less than
4 \$5,000.
