A BILL

To assign a resident inspector to certain commercial nuclear power plants to conduct inspections of decommissioning activities and spent nuclear fuel transfer activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Increasing Nuclear
5 Safety Protocols for Extended Canister Transfers Act” or
6 the “INSPECT Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INSPECTION OF DECOMMISSIONING ACTIVITY AND**
2 **SPENT NUCLEAR FUEL TRANSFER ACTIVITY.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Chairman of the Nuclear
4 Regulatory Commission shall assign, for the duration de-
5 scribed in subsection (b), a resident inspector to each com-
6 mercial nuclear power plant that has permanently ceased
7 operation to conduct inspections of decommissioning ac-
8 tivities and spent nuclear fuel transfer activities of the
9 commercial nuclear power plant.

10 (b) DURATION DESCRIBED.—The duration described
11 in this subsection is the period of time it takes to transfer
12 all spent nuclear fuel from the spent fuel pools of the com-
13 mercial nuclear power plant.

14 (c) REASSIGNMENT.—If there are no decommis-
15 sioning activities or spent nuclear fuel transfer activities
16 at the commercial nuclear power plant to which a resident
17 inspector is assigned under subsection (a), the Chairman
18 of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission may assign such
19 resident inspector to a different commercial nuclear power
20 plant.
