1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “State Sovereignty in
3 Voting Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. PERMITTING STATES TO REQUIRE VOTER REG-**
5 **ISTRATION APPLICANTS USING FEDERAL**
6 **MAIL FORM TO SUBMIT DOCUMENTARY EVI-**
7 **DENCE OF CITIZENSHIP AS CONDITION OF**
8 **ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATION.**

9 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 6(a)(1) of the National
10 Voter Registration Act of 1993 (52 U.S.C. 20505(a)(1))
11 is amended by striking the period at the end and inserting
12 the following: “, except that a State may require an appli-
13 cant who submits such form to provide documentary evi-
14 dence of the applicant’s citizenship as a condition of the
15 State’s acceptance of the form.”.

16 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
17 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to elections for
18 Federal office held after the date of the enactment of this
19 Act.
