A BILL

To prohibit the use of funds for the Lifeline program, and
for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RESCISSION; PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS**

4 **FOR THE LIFELINE PROGRAM.**

5 (a) RESCISSION.—Of the unobligated balances of
6 funds available for “Federal Communications Commis-
7 sion—Salaries and Expenses” for fiscal year 2013,
8 \$2,200,000,000 are hereby rescinded.

1 (b) LIMITATION.—None of the funds made available
2 for “Federal Communications Commission—Salaries and
3 Expenses” for fiscal year 2013 may be used for the Life-
4 line program under sections 54.400 through 54.417 of
5 title 47, code of Federal Regulations (as in effect on the
6 date of the enactment of this Act).

7 (c) USE OF RESCINDED AMOUNTS.—

8 (1) The amount otherwise made available for
9 “Department of Transportation—Federal Aviation
10 Administration—Operations” for fiscal year 2013 is
11 hereby increased by \$500,000,000.

12 (2) The amount otherwise made available for
13 “Department of Defense—Operation and Mainte-
14 nance, Navy” for fiscal year 2013 is hereby in-
15 creased by \$1,600,000,000.

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
