JOINT RESOLUTION

Directing the President to remove United States Armed Forces deployed to Iraq or Syria on or after August 7, 2014, other than Armed Forces required to protect United States diplomatic facilities and personnel, from Iraq and Syria.

3 SHORT TITLE

4 SECTION 1. This joint resolution may be cited as the

5 “Constitutional Alternative to the War Powers Iraq and

6 Syria Withdrawal Resolution”.

1 REMOVAL OF UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES FROM IRAQ
2 AND SYRIA

3 SEC. 2. Congress directs the President to remove the
4 United States Armed Forces deployed to Iraq or Syria on
5 or after August 7, 2014, other than Armed Forces re-
6 quired to protect United States diplomatic facilities and
7 personnel, from Iraq and Syria—

8 (1) by no later than the end of the period of 30
9 days beginning on the date of the enactment of this
10 joint resolution; or

11 (2) if the President determines that it is not
12 safe to remove such United States Armed Forces be-
13 fore the end of that period, by no later than Decem-
14 ber 31, 2015, or such earlier date as the President
15 determines that the Armed Forces can safely be re-
16 moved.
