## RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 336) to make improvements to certain defense and security assistance provisions and to authorize the appropriation of funds to Israel, to reauthorize the United States-Jordan Defense Cooperation Act of 2015, and to halt the wholesale slaughter of the Syrian people, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-  
2       olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in  
3       the House of the bill (H.R. 336) to make improvements  
4       to certain defense and security assistance provisions and  
5       to authorize the appropriation of funds to Israel, to reau-

1 thorize the United States-Jordan Defense Cooperation Act  
2 of 2015, and to halt the wholesale slaughter of the Syrian  
3 people, and for other purposes. All points of order against  
4 consideration of the bill are waived. The bill shall be con-  
5 sidered as read. All points of order against provisions in  
6 the bill are waived. The previous question shall be consid-  
7 ered as ordered on the bill and on any amendment thereto  
8 to final passage without intervening motion except—

9           (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-  
10       trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of  
11       the Committee on Foreign Affairs; and

12           (2) one motion to recommit.

13       SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to  
14 the consideration of H.R. 336.
