RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to prevent duplicative and overlapping government programs.

- 1 Resolved, That clause 3 of rule XIII of the Rules of the House of Representatives is amended by adding at the 3 end the following new paragraph: 4 "(i)(1) The report accompanying each bill or joint resolution of a public character reported by any committee 5
- (including the Committee on Appropriations and the Com-
- mittee on the Budget) shall contain— 7

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- 8 "(A) an analysis by the Congressional Research
- 9 Service to determine if the bill or joint resolution
- 10 creates any new Federal program, office, or initia-

- 1 tive that would duplicate or overlap any existing
- 2 Federal program, office, or initiative with similar
- mission, purpose, goals, or activities along with a
- 4 listing of all of the overlapping or duplicative Fed-
- 5 eral program or programs, office or offices, or initia-
- 6 tive or initiatives; and
- 7 "(B) an explanation provided by the committee
- 8 as to why the creation of each new program, office,
- 9 or initiative is necessary if a similar program or pro-
- grams, office or offices, or initiative or initiatives
- 11 exist.
- 12 "(2)(A) It shall not be in order to consider a bill or
- 13 joint resolution described in subparagraph (1) unless the
- 14 committee of jurisdiction has prepared and posted on its
- 15 website an overlapping and duplicative program analysis
- 16 and explanation for the bill or joint resolution.
- 17 "(B) The analysis and explanation required by this
- 18 subparagraph shall contain—
- "(i) an analysis by the Congressional Research
- 20 Service to determine if the bill or joint resolution
- creates any new Federal program, office, or initia-
- 22 tive that would duplicate or overlap any existing
- Federal program, office, or initiative with similar
- 24 mission, purpose, goals, or activities along with a
- listing of all of the overlapping or duplicative Fed-

- eral program or programs, office or offices, or initiative or initiatives; and
- "(ii) an explanation provided by the committee as to why the creation of each new program, office, or initiative is necessary if a similar program or programs, office or offices, or initiative or initiatives exist.
- 8 "(C) This subparagraph may be waived by joint 9 agreement of the majority leader and the minority leader 10 upon their certification that such waiver is necessary as 11 a result of a significant disruption to House facilities or 12 to the availability of the Internet or for a bill or joint reso-13 lution that carries an emergency designation.".

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
