Mr. PERLMUTTER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for further consideration of the bill (H.R. 627) to amend the Truth in Lending Act to establish fair and transparent practices relating to the extension of credit under an open end consumer credit plan, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for further

1 consideration of the bill (H.R. 627) to amend the Truth
2 in Lending Act to establish fair and transparent practices
3 relating to the extension of credit under an open end con-
4 sumer credit plan, and for other purposes. No general de-
5 bate shall be in order pursuant to this resolution. The bill
6 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute
7 rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill
8 for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule
9 the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended
10 by the Committee on Financial Services now printed in
11 the bill. The committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
12 stitute shall be considered as read. All points of order
13 against the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
14 stitute are waived except those arising under clause 10
15 of rule XXI. Notwithstanding clause 11 of rule XVIII, no
16 amendment to the committee amendment in the nature
17 of a substitute shall be in order except those printed in
18 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
19 resolution. Each such amendment may be offered only in
20 the order printed in the report, may be offered only by
21 a Member designated in the report, shall be considered
22 as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the
23 report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
24 an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
25 not be subject to a demand for division of the question

1 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points
2 of order against such amendments are waived except those
3 arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion
4 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
5 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
6 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may
7 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
8 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
9 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.
10 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
11 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
12 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
13 or without instructions.
