A BILL

To amend title XX of the Social Security Act to expand the activities authorized under adult protective services demonstration grants.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Guardianship Grant
5 Flexibility Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXPANDING ACTIVITIES AUTHORIZED UNDER**
7 **ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES DEMONSTRA-**
8 **TION GRANTS.**

9 Section 2042(c)(2) of the Social Security Act (42
10 U.S.C. 1397m–1(c)(2)) is amended—

1 (1) in subparagraph (E), by striking “or” at
2 the end;

3 (2) by redesignating subparagraph (F) as sub-
4 paragraph (G); and

5 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (E) the fol-
6 lowing new subparagraph:

7 “(F) State court programs for recruiting
8 and training law students through clinics super-
9 vised by a licensed attorney to provide represen-
10 tation for respondents in guardianship cases,
11 and to serve as guardians ad litem; or”.
