A BILL

To amend chapter 63 of title 5, United States Code, to modify the rate of accrual of annual leave for administrative law judges, contract appeals board members, and immigration judges.

1 **SECTION 1. ACCRUAL RATE OF ANNUAL LEAVE FOR AD-**
 2 **MINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES, CONTRACT AP-**
 3 **PEALS BOARD MEMBERS, AND IMMIGRATION**
 4 **JUDGES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6303 of title 5, United
 6 States Code, is amended by striking subsection (f) and in-
 7 serting the following:

8 “(f) Notwithstanding any other provision of this sec-
 9 tion, the rate of accrual of annual leave under subsection
 10 (a) shall be 1 day for each full biweekly pay period in the
 11 case of any employee who—

12 “(1) holds a position which is subject to—

13 “(A) section 5372, 5372a, 5376, or 5383;

14 or

15 “(B) a pay system equivalent to a pay sys-
 16 tem to which any provision under paragraph (1)
 17 applies, as determined by the Office of Per-
 18 sonnel Management; or

19 “(2) is an immigration judge as defined under
 20 section 101(b)(4) of the Immigration and Nation-
 21 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(b)(4)).”.

22 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 23 this section shall take effect on the first day of the first
 24 applicable pay period beginning on or after 30 days after
 25 the date of enactment of this Act.
