#### 6 SEC. 2. COST SHARE FOR THE MILK RIVER PROJECT.

- 7 (a) DEFINITION OF MILK RIVER PROJECT.—
- 8 (1) IN GENERAL.—In this Act, the term "Milk
  9 River Project" means the Bureau of Reclamation
  10 project authorized by the Secretary of the Interior

1	on March 14, 1903, under the Act of June $17$ , 1902
2	(32 Stat. 388, chapter 1093), commencing at Lake
3	Sherburne and providing water to a point approxi-
4	mately 6 miles east of Nashua, Montana.
5	(2) INCLUSIONS.—The term "Milk River
6	Project" includes—
7	(A) Swiftcurrent Dike;
8	(B) Lake Sherburne;
9	(C) Nelson and Fresno dams, dikes, and
10	reservoirs;
11	(D) St. Mary, Dodson, Vandalia, and Par-
12	adise Diversion dams;
13	(E) Dodson pumping plant; and
14	(F) associated siphons, canals, drops,
15	laterals, and drains.
16	(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost of
17	the operation, maintenance, repair, and replacement of the
18	Milk River Project shall be 75 percent, which shall not
19	be reimbursable to the United States.

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
