A BILL

To extend the National Alzheimer's Project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “NAPA Reauthorization
5 ~~Act~~”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROJECT.**

2 Section 2 of the National Alzheimer's Project Act (42
3 U.S.C. 11225) is amended—

4 (1) in subsection (c)—

5 (A) in paragraph (2), by striking “and co-
6 ordination of” and inserting “on, and coordina-
7 tion of,”;

8 (B) in paragraph (4)—

9 (i) by redesignating subparagraphs
10 (A) and (B) as subparagraphs (B) and
11 (C), respectively; and

12 (ii) by inserting before subparagraph
13 (B), as so redesignated, the following:

14 “(A) promotion of healthy aging and re-
15 duction of risk factors for Alzheimer’s,”;

16 (C) in paragraph (5), by striking “; and”
17 and inserting a semicolon;

18 (D) by redesignating paragraph (6) as
19 paragraph (7); and

20 (E) by inserting after paragraph (5) the
21 following:

22 “(6) provide information on, and promote the
23 adoption of, healthy behaviors that may reduce the
24 risk of cognitive decline and promote and protect
25 cognitive health; and”;

26 (2) in subsection (d)(2)—

1 (A) by inserting “, across public and pri-
2 vate sectors,” after “Nation’s progress”; and

3 (B) by inserting “, including consideration
4 of public-private collaborations, as appropriate”
5 before the period;

6 (3) in subsection (c)—

7 (A) in paragraph (2)—

8 (i) in subparagraph (A), by adding at
9 the end the following:

10 “(xi) A designee of the Department of
11 Justice.

12 “(xii) A designee of the Federal
13 Emergency Management Agency.

14 “(xiii) A designee of the Social Secu-
15 rity Administration.

16 “(xiv) A designee of the Office of
17 Management and Budget.

18 “(xv) 1 or more other designees of the
19 Department of Health and Human Serv-
20 ices, as determined by the Secretary of
21 Health and Human Services.”; and

22 (ii) in subparagraph (B)—

23 (I) in clause (v)—

1 (aa) by striking “2 research-
 2 ers” and inserting “3 research-
 3 ers”; and

4 (bb) by striking “; and” and
 5 inserting “; including at least one
 6 researcher with demonstrated ex-
 7 perience in recruitment and re-
 8 tention of diverse cohorts of trial
 9 participants;”;

10 (H) in clause (vi), by striking the
 11 period and inserting “; and”; and

12 (III) by adding at the end the
 13 following:

14 “(vii) an individual with a diagnosis of
 15 Alzheimer’s disease.”;

16 (B) in paragraph (5)—

17 (i) in subparagraph (A)—

16 (ii) by striking “; and” and inserting
17 a semicolon;

18 (D) by redesignating paragraph (6) as
19 paragraph (7); and

20 (E) by inserting after paragraph (5) the fol-
21 lowing:

22 “(6) provide information on, and promote the
23 adoption of, healthy behaviors that may reduce the
24 risk of cognitive decline and promote and protect cog-
25 nitive health; and”;

1 (2) *in subsection (d)(2)—*

2 (A) *by inserting “, across public and pri-*
3 *vate sectors,” after “Nation’s progress”; and*

4 (B) *by inserting “, including consideration*
5 *of public-private collaborations, as appropriate”*
6 *before the period;*

7 (3) *in subsection (e)—*

19 *Human Services, at least one of whom has*
20 *expertise in risk factors associated with the*
21 *development or the progression of Alz-*
22 *heimer’s.*”*; and*

1 (I) *in the matter preceding clause*
2 (i), *by striking “12” and inserting*
3 “15”;

4 (II) *in clause (v)—*

5 (aa) *by striking “2 research-*
6 *ers” and inserting “3 research-*
7 *ers”;* and

8 (bb) *by striking “; and” and*
9 *inserting “, including at least one*
10 *researcher with demonstrated ex-*
11 *perience in recruitment and reten-*
12 *tion of diverse cohorts of trial*
13 *participants;”;*

14 (III) *in clause (vi), by striking*
15 *the period and inserting a semicolon;*
16 and

17 (IV) *by adding at the end the fol-*
18 *lowing:*

19 “(vii) *1 individual with a diagnosis of*
20 *Alzheimer’s disease; and*

21 “(viii) *1 representative from a histori-*
22 *cally underserved population whose lifetime*
23 *risk for developing Alzheimer’s is markedly*
24 *higher than that of other populations.”;*
