- 3 SECTION 1. CARBON DIOXIDE REDUCTIONS IN CHINA,
- 4 INDIA, AND RUSSIA.
- 5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Ad-
- 6 ministrator of the Environmental Protection Agency or
- 7 the head of any other Federal agency shall not regulate
- 8 carbon dioxide emissions until the date on which the Sec-
- 9 retary of Commerce certifies in writing that each of the
- 10 People's Republic of China, the Republic of India, and

- 1 Russia have initiated measures that require carbon dioxide
- 2 emission reductions that are substantially similar to the
- 3 carbon dioxide emission reductions proposed for the

4 United States.
