Ms. MURKOWSKI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

For the relief of Michael G. Faber.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT TO SEALASKA CORPORATION.**

4 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

5 (1) AFFECTED INDIVIDUAL.—The term “af-
6 fected individual” means Michael G. Faber, who—

7 (A) is a former resident of the State of
8 Alaska; and

9 (B) was previously enrolled in Sealaska
10 Corporation under roll number 13–752–39665–
11 01.

1 (2) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
2 the Secretary of the Interior.

3 (b) REVOCATION OF MEMBERSHIP IN METLAKATLA
4 INDIAN COMMUNITY.—Effective on the date on which the
5 affected individual submits written notice to the
6 Metlakatla Indian Community revoking the membership of
7 the affected individual in the Metlakatla Indian Commu-
8 nity, the membership of the affected individual in the
9 Metlakatla Indian Community shall be considered to be
10 revoked.

11 (c) REINSTATEMENT.—Notwithstanding any other
12 provision of law, pursuant to section 5 of the Alaska Na-
13 tive Claims Settlement Act (43 U.S.C. 1604), the Sec-
14 retary shall, immediately after the affected individual sub-
15 mits the notice under subsection (b)—

16 (1) reinstate the affected individual to the
17 shareholder roll of Sealaska Corporation; and

18 (2) ensure the provision to the affected indi-
19 vidual of the number of shares originally allocated to
20 the affected individual by Sealaska Corporation.

21 (d) EFFECT OF SECTION.—Nothing in this section
22 provides to the affected individual any retroactive benefit
23 relating to membership in—

24 (1) Sealaska Corporation; or

1 (2) the Metlakatla Indian Community.

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
