A BILL

To extend the authority of the Department of the Army to carry out a child development center project in Fort Gordon, Georgia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fort Gordon Child
5 Development Center Expansion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY TO CARRY OUT FORT**
7 **GORDON CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER**
8 **PROJECT.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 2002 of
10 the Military Construction Authorization Act for Fiscal

1 Year 2021 (division B of Public Law 116–283; 134 Stat.
 2 4294), the authorization under section 2865 of that Act
 3 (10 U.S.C. 2802 note) for the project described in sub-
 4 section (b) in Fort Gordon, Georgia, shall remain in effect
 5 until October 1, 2024, or the date of the enactment of
 6 an Act authorizing funds for military construction for fis-
 7 cal year 2025, whichever is later.

8 (b) PROJECT DESCRIBED.—The project described in
 9 this subsection is the following:
