A BILL

To amend the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act to allow schools that participate in the school lunch program to serve whole milk, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Milk in Lunches for
5 Kids Act of 2019” or the “MILK Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. WHOLE MILK PERMISSIBLE.**

7 Section 9(a)(2)(A) of the Richard B. Russell National
8 School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1758(a)(2)(A)) is amend-
9 ed—

1 (1) in clause (i), by striking “milk.” and all
2 that follows through “(7 U.S.C. 5341)” and insert-
3 ing “milk;”; and

4 (2) in clause (ii), by striking “milk” the first
5 place it appears and inserting “milk, flavored and
6 unflavored whole milk, milk with 2 percent fat,”.

7 **SEC. 3. HEALTHY MILK FAT.**

8 The Secretary of Agriculture shall revise section
9 210.10 of title 7, Code of Federal Regulations (or suc-
10 cessor regulations), to exclude milk fat from the calcula-
11 tion of the average saturated fat content of a meal.

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
