To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for the eligibility of parents of certain deceased veterans for interment in national cemeteries.

- 3 SECTION 1. INTERMENT IN NATIONAL CEMETERIES OF
- 4 PARENTS OF CERTAIN DECEASED VETERANS.
- 5 (a) Interment of Parents of Certain De-
- 6 CEASED VETERANS.—Section 2402 of title 38, United
- 7 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 8 lowing new paragraph:
- 9 "(9) If the Secretary determines there is
- 10 enough space in open national cemeteries, the parent

- 1 of a person listed in any of paragraphs (1) through
- 2 (4) or paragraph (7) who, at the time of the par-
- 3 ent's death, does not have a spouse, surviving
- 4 spouse, or child who has been interred, or who, if de-
- 5 ceased, would be eligible to be interred, in a national
- 6 cemetery pursuant to paragraph (5).".
- 7 (b) Effective Date.—Paragraph (9) of section
- 8 2402 of title 38, United States Code, shall apply with re-
- 9 spect to the death of an eligible parent on or after the
- 10 date of the enactment of this Act.
