## A BILL

To rename the Homestead National Monument of America  
near Beatrice, Nebraska, as the Homestead National  
Historical Park.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. HOMESTEAD NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The first section of the Act of  
5 March 19, 1936 (49 Stat. 1184, chapter 157; 16 U.S.C.  
6 450u) is amended by striking “designated” and all that  
7 follows through the end and inserting “designated as the  
8 ‘Homestead National Historical Park’.”.

1           (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
3 States to the unit of the National Park System known  
4 as “The Homestead National Monument of America”  
5 shall be considered to be a reference to the “Homestead  
6 National Historical Park”.

7           (c) EFFECT.—Nothing in this Act or an amendment  
8 made by this Act authorizes a change in the management  
9 of the Homestead National Historical Park redesignated  
10 under subsection (a).
