A BILL

To ensure that holders of flood insurance policies under the National Flood Insurance Program do not receive premium refunds for coverage of second homes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NO REFUNDS UNDER NATIONAL FLOOD INSUR-**
4 **ANCE PROGRAM FOR COVERAGE OF SECOND**
5 **HOMES.**

6 (a) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “National
7 Flood Insurance Program” means the program estab-
8 lished under the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968
9 (42 U.S.C. 4001 et seq.).

1 (b) NO REFUNDS FOR COVERAGE OF SECOND
2 HOMES.—Notwithstanding section 3(a)(4) of the Home-
3 owner Flood Insurance Affordability Act of 2014 or any
4 other provision of law, in the case of flood insurance cov-
5 erage under the National Flood Insurance Program for
6 a residential property that is not the primary residence
7 of an individual (as that term is used in section
8 1307(a)(2)(A) of the National Flood Insurance Act of
9 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4014(a)(2)(A))), the Administrator of
10 the Federal Emergency Management Agency may not re-
11 fund any premium for such coverage collected in excess
12 of the rates required under the provisions of, and amend-
13 ments made by, section 3 of the Homeowner Flood Insur-
14 ance Affordability Act of 2014.

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
