1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF CHEMICAL FACILITY ANTI-TER-**
2 **RORISM STANDARDS PROGRAM OF THE DE-**
3 **PARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY.**

4 Section 5 of the Protecting and Securing Chemical
5 Facilities from Terrorist Attacks Act of 2014 (6 U.S.C.
6 621 note) is amended by striking “July 27, 2023” and
7 inserting “October 1, 2028”.
