A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to increase the Federal medical assistance percentage for States that provide Medicaid coverage for telehealth services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rural and Frontier
5 Telehealth Expansion Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASED FMAP FOR STATES PROVIDING MED-**
2 **ICAID COVERAGE FOR TELEHEALTH SERV-**
3 **ICES.**

4 Section 1905(b) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
5 1396d(b)) is amended, in the first sentence—

6 (1) by striking “and (5)” and inserting “(5)”;

7 and

8 (2) by inserting “, and (6) in the case of a fron-
9 tier State (as defined in section
10 1886(d)(3)(E)(iii)(II)) or a State where less than 90
11 percent of the total population has access to fixed
12 terrestrial broadband service with at least 25 mega-
13 bits per second (Mbps) download speed and 3 Mbps
14 upload speed (according to the most recently avail-
15 able annual Broadband Deployment Report of the
16 Federal Communications Commission) that, as de-
17 termined by the Secretary, provides medical assist-
18 ance for telehealth services (including audio-only
19 telehealth services) for a majority of the services for
20 which medical assistance is available under the State
21 plan (or a waiver of such plan) and for which tele-
22 health is appropriate and provides such services at
23 a level that is not less than the level at which the
24 State provided such services on January 1, 2021,
25 the Federal medical assistance percentage, as deter-
26 mined under this subsection and subsection (y), shall

1 be increased by 5 percentage points with respect to
2 medical assistance for telehealth services” before the
3 period.

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
