A BILL

To amend the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 to provide families year-round access to nutrition incentives under the Gus Schumacher Nutrition Incentive Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Supporting all Healthy
5 Options when Purchasing Produce Act of 2023” or the
6 “SHOPP Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. NUTRITION INCENTIVES UNDER GUS SCHUMACHER**
2 **NUTRITION INCENTIVE PROGRAM.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 4405 of the Food, Con-
4 servation, and Energy Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 7517) is
5 amended—

6 (1) in subsection (b)(2)(B)—

7 (A) by redesignating clauses (ix) and (x)
8 as clauses (x) and (xi), respectively; and

9 (B) by inserting after clause (viii) the fol-
10 lowing:

11 “(ix) increase the year-round avail-
12 ability of the incentive described in sub-
13 paragraph (A)(ii)(II) by offering fresh fro-
14 zen fruits or vegetables;” and

15 (2) in subsection (c)—

16 (A) in paragraph (1)(A), by striking
17 “fruits and vegetables” and inserting “fruits,
18 vegetables, and legumes”; and

19 (B) in paragraph (3), by striking “fresh
20 fruits and vegetables” each place it appears and
21 inserting “fresh or fresh frozen fruits, vegeta-
22 bles, and legumes”.

23 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
24 subsection (a) shall take effect on March 6, 2024.
