6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.89 of the Har7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 certain artichokes) is amended—

9 (1) by striking "13.8%" and inserting
10 "13.34%"; and

(2) by striking "12/31/2009" and inserting
 "12/31/2011".

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
4 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
5 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
6 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
