2 **THE NUMBER OF QUALIFIED PLUG-IN ELEC-**
3 **TRIC DRIVE MOTOR VEHICLES ELIGIBLE FOR**
4 **CREDIT.**

5 Paragraph (2) of section 30D(e) of the Internal Rev-
6 enue Code of 1986 is amended by striking “200,000” and
7 inserting “500,000”.

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
