A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain woven mesh fabric.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WOVEN MESH FABRIC.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Woven mesh fabric, certified by the importer as made of perfluoroalkoxy copolymer resin formed into fibers measuring 100 to 120 microns in diameter (provided for in subheading 5407.71.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
