## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain window shade material.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN WINDOW SHADE MATERIAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Window shade material in rolls measuring between 300 and 500 square feet composed of bamboo reeds and/or bamboo slats between 1 mm and 13 mm wide, and/or bamboo cane between 2 mm and 12 mm in diameter, woven with polyester yarn into a repeating pattern which may also include grass, paper and/or jute materials (provided for in subheading 4601.92.20) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
 4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
