To suspend temporarily the duty on certain adjustable metal lighting fixtures.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN ADJUSTABLE METAL LIGHTING FIX-**
4 **TURES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:
