Mr. COTTON (for himself and Mr. RISCH) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To prohibit any rule or guidance that bans gas stoves in the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Trying to Obses-

5 sively Vilify Energy Act” or the “STOVE Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON PROMULGATING ANY RULE OR**
7 **GUIDANCE THAT BANS GAS STOVES IN THE**
8 **UNITED STATES.**

9 No Federal agency may propose, implement, or final-

10 ize a rule or guidance that categorically restricts or bans

- 1 the use and purchase of natural gas-powered appliances
- 2 in the United States.
