3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Action for Dental
5 Health Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF GRANT PROGRAM FOR IN-**
7 **NOVATIVE DENTAL PROGRAMS.**

8 Section 340G(f) of the Public Health Service Act (42
9 U.S.C. 256g(f)) is amended by striking “\$13,903,000 for
10 each of fiscal years 2019 through 2023” and inserting

1 “\$15,200,000 for fiscal year 2024, \$15,500,000 for fiscal
2 year 2025, and \$15,800,000 for fiscal year 2026, to re-
3 main available until expended”.
