A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to require reporting on enforcement and oversight of pharmacy access requirements under Medicare part D.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pharmacy Access
5 Oversight and Reporting Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORTING ON ENFORCEMENT AND OVERSIGHT OF**
2 **PHARMACY ACCESS REQUIREMENTS.**

3 Section 1860D–42 of the Social Security Act (42
4 U.S.C. 1395w–152) is amended by adding at the end the
5 following new subsection:

6 “(e) BIENNIAL REPORT ON ENFORCEMENT AND
7 OVERSIGHT OF PHARMACY ACCESS REQUIREMENTS.—

8 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 2 years
9 after the date of enactment of this subsection, and
10 at least once every 2 years thereafter, the Secretary
11 shall publish a report on enforcement and oversight
12 actions and activities undertaken by the Secretary
13 with respect to the requirements under section
14 1860D–4(b)(1).

15 “(2) LIMITATION.—A report under paragraph
16 (1) shall not disclose—

17 “(A) identifiable information about individ-
18 uals or entities unless such information is oth-
19 erwise publicly available; or

20 “(B) trade secrets with respect to any enti-
21 ties.”.

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
