# SEC. 2. DEVELOPMENT AND PRODUCTION OF BIOLOGICAL PRODUCTS.

3 Subpart 1 of part F of title III of the Public Health
4 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 262 et seq.) is amended by adding
5 at the end the following:

## 6 "SEC. 352A. DEVELOPMENT AND PRODUCTION OF BIOLOGI7 CAL PRODUCTS.

"(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may design, con-8 9 struct, and operate one or more facilities for the purpose of developing and producing biological products to meet 10 11 critical national needs for such biological products, in response to potential bioterrorist attacks or to naturally oc-12 curring pathogens, for which the Secretary determines 13 14 that private industry has not devoted adequate development effort, or has not produced adequate stocks of, such 15 16 needed biological products.

17 "(b) COMPETITIVE AWARD.—In carrying out the au-18 thority described in subsection (a), the Secretary—

"(1) shall ensure that there is competition and
may establish a public-private partnership to design,
construct, own, and operate a facility described in
subsection (a); and

24 transactions under section 319L to establish such a
25 facility.".
