- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Linear Generator Par-
- 5 ity Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. INCLUDING FUEL CELLS USING
- 7 ELECTROMECHANICAL PROCESSES FOR PUR-
- 8 POSES OF THE ENERGY TAX CREDIT.
- 9 (a) In General.—Paragraph (1) of section 48(c) of
- 10 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

1	(1) in subparagraph (A)(i), by inserting "or
2	electromechanical" after "electrochemical", and
3	(2) in subparagraph (C)—
4	(A) by inserting ", or linear generator as-
5	sembly," after "a fuel cell stack assembly", and
6	(B) by striking "electrochemical means"
7	and inserting "electrochemical or
8	electromechanical means without the use of ro-
9	tating parts".
10	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
11	this section shall apply to property placed in service after
12	the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
